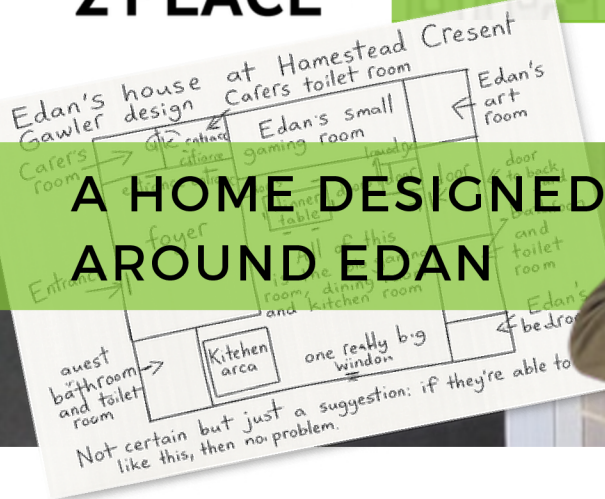




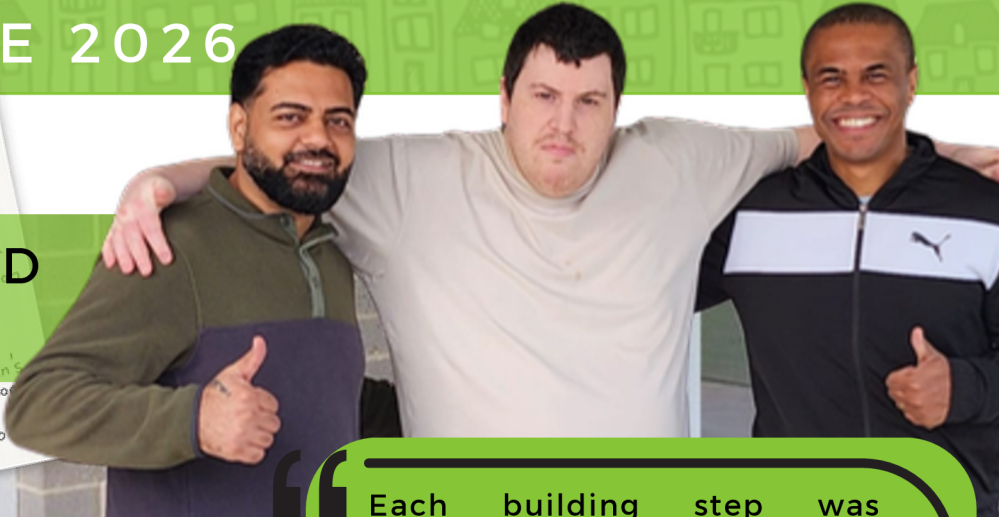

How to Apply for SDA

A simple guide to eligibility and the process

Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) is housing funded through the NDIS for people with very high support needs or extreme functional impairment.



Talk to your NDIS contact about your housing needs & confirm your SDA eligibility

3 questions to determine eligibility:

- Do you have extreme functional impairment or very high support needs?
- Do you have an SDA needs requirement?
- Does SDA meet the NDIS funding criteria for you?



Complete a Home and Living Supports Request form & gather supporting evidence

Evidence may include:

- Home & Living Supports Request
- Housing Assessment Form
- Statement of Support
- Personal Housing Statement/Plan
- Functional Capacity Assessment
- Psychological Assessment Report



Submit the application & evidence to the NDIA

Work with your NDIS contact to submit the Home and Living Supports Request form and all supporting documentation to the NDIA.

If you don't have a support coordinator, you can submit the application directly.



The NDIA reviews your application & will notify you of their decision

Want to know more about your SDA options? Speak with Access 2 Place — you can explore your housing options while staying with Access 2 Place as your SDA provider.

Cooks Corner

Veggie + Chicken Noodle Soup

INGREDIENTS

- 1 Tablespoon olive oil
- 1 Onion, chopped
- 2 Carrots, chopped
- 2 Celery sticks, chopped
- 2 Garlic cloves, crushed
- 1 litre chicken stock
- 1 cup cooked shredded chicken
- 1 cup small pasta or noodles
- 1 cup frozen peas or corn

METHOD

STEP 1: HEAT THE OIL IN A LARGE POT AND COOK THE ONION, CARROT, CELERY AND GARLIC FOR A FEW MINUTES UNTIL SOFTENED.

STEP 2: ADD THE STOCK AND BRING TO THE BOIL.

STEP 3: ADD THE NOODLES OR PASTA AND COOK UNTIL SOFT.

STEP 4: STIR THROUGH THE CHICKEN AND VEGETABLES, THEN SIMMER FOR A FEW MORE MINUTES.

STEP 5: SEASON WITH SALT AND PEPPER, THEN SERVE WARM.
